It has been quite a season since our last letter but I will try to fill you in on what we have been doing to keep out of mischief.

Since News Letter #19, (8/04), we sold property and had the capital to purchase and remodel the warehouse into "The Boat Shed" and purchase ALUMINUM! Our first load of 1" aluminum for the keelson arrived in February 2005.

Loren and our welder, Lee, built a 96' long fabrication table to layout and weld the keelson which allowed for very accurate alignment and welding of the parts. The keelson was then suspended in position from the rafters and the supporting steel framework built up under it. This proved to be a very simple and accurate system for setting the keelson.
